- 1. Starting in Genesis we learn that life comes from Jesus, our Creator, and obedience would have sustained that life eternally. (John 1:3<sup>1</sup>, 10<sup>3</sup>; Ephesians 3:9<sup>2</sup>; Genesis 1:1, 25; 2:17)
- 2. In love, the Creator who made everything, also told our first parents not to eat from one tree and warned them of the consequences. Either God was telling the truth–they would die, or the serpent was telling the truth–they wouldn't die. (Genesis 2:17<sup>5</sup>; 3:4<sup>6</sup>)
- 3. While sleeping, we are unconscious and unaware of the passing of time. The Bible refers to death as a dreamless state of sleep 66 times in 17 books of the Bible. (Ecclesiastes 9:5<sup>13</sup>; Psalm 115:17)
- 4. Nowhere in the Bible are we told we have an immortal soul. Only God has immortality. At Christ's second coming He will call the dead to life, and the saints will put on immortality at that time. (1 Timothy 6:16<sup>39</sup>; 1 Corinthians 15:51, 52<sup>41</sup>)
- 5. We may experience the "sleep" of the first death before Jesus returns, but Jesus taught us we can avoid the second, eternal death. (John 5:24<sup>37</sup>; 8:51<sup>38</sup>; Revelation 20:6; 2:11; 21:8)
- 6. Jesus spoke life into the decomposing body of Lazarus before the general resurrection at the end. And before His second coming He has the same power to speak spiritual life into our stinky selfish lives. When we cooperate with His directives, He will give us His abundant life. (John 11:43, 44; 11:39<sup>30</sup>; 6:63<sup>36</sup>; 8:51<sup>38</sup>; 11:40<sup>31</sup>; 10:10)
